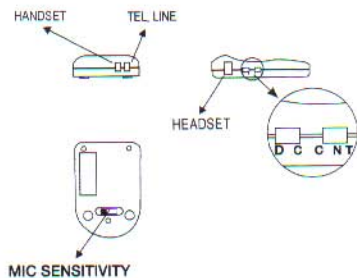
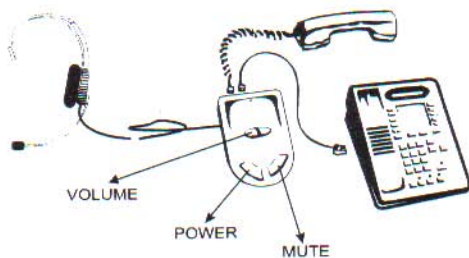

Telephone Headset Amplifier Manual**

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using your telephone equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury to persons including the following:

1. Do not use this product near water.
2. Avoid using a telephone (other than cordless type) during an electrical storm. There may be a remote risk of electric shock from lightning.
3. Do not use the telephone to report a gas leak in the vicinity of the leak.
4. Use only the power cord and batteries indicated in this manual. Do not dispose of batteries in a fire. They may explode. Check with local codes for possible special disposal instructions.



TAP-2001 INSTALLATION AND OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

I. Installation:

1. Install either 2 AA size or 1.5V batteries in the rear of your amplifier or power supply - **NOT BOTH**.
2. Connect tel line of amplifier to telephone handset jack.
3. Connect telephone handset to the handset jack of amplifier.
4. Connect headset to the headset jack of amplifier.

II. Setting Up:

1. Selecting compatibility telephone system: Please adjust the wire Switch to select the mode NT or C.
2. Adjust Microphone Sensitivity and Receiver volume to maximum. When you hear yourself from the headset as well as from the telephone handset, your amplifier is properly set up.
3. Set the Comp Switch position to "D" for digital setting and electronic setting, or "C" for carbon setting.

III. Operation: (Amplifier ON, using headset; Amplifier OFF using handset)

1. To make a phone call:
Press Power button – power light on
– OFF-HOOK the handset
– Listen for dial tone – set receive volume
– to finish the phone call – ON-HOOK the handset – press Power button again – power light off.
2. Adjust transmit volume (microphone)
3. To receive a call:
Press power button – power light on
– OFF-HOOK the handset – talking
– to finish the phone call, – ON-HOOK the handset
Press power button again – power light off
4. Mute button
While talking on phone – press mute button (red light flashes)
– this will mute your microphone – press mute button again (red light off) – microphone switch on again.
